Aromas & Visuals: Plum, strawberry, rosemary, sage, huckleberry, prosciutto, sweet floral notes, roasted nutty aromas, butter pretzels.

Flavors & Mouthfeel: Fuji apple, bright and fresh, pomegranite, red current, cranberry, blackberry, savory, peppery, unbuttered popcorn kernels.
