The Wine:

Aromas & Visuals: Roasted nutty aromas, plum, dried basil, rosemary, sage, huckleberry, prosciutto, sweet floral notes, insanely complex, flavor development is constantly evolving in the glass.

Flavors & Mouthfeel: So different on the palate, gala apple, tons of acid, bright and fresh, pomegranite, red current, cranberry, blackberry.
